AIM

The Certificate in Community Counselling trains lay counsellors to work alongside leaders of the local church in effective caring strategies and assists with 'lifeskills' training in a variety of community settings.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- A Matriculation Certificate or equivalent
- Age exemption (Senior Certificate and a minimum of 22 years of age)
- 40 years of age and over without any school certificate

TIME COMMITMENT

- Two nights per week over a minimum of 2 ½ years plus personal study
- Monday and Thursday, 18h00 - 21h00
- 2008 classes commence 4 February, 10 April, 7 July and 15 September

COST

- R780 per 6-credit module
- Total cost of programme: R15 600
